NOTE: 2007 CBC Appendix 1 Section 105.5 states: "Every permit issued shall become invalid unless the work on the site authorized by such permit is commenced within 180 days after issuance, or if the work authorized on the site by such permit is suspended or abandoned for a period of 180 days after the time the work is commenced. The building official is authorized to grant, in writing, one or more extensions of time, for periods not more than 180 days each. The extension shall be requested in writing and justifiable cause demonstrated."

- Work done between inspections must be substantial enough in nature to allow a determination that progress is being made toward the completion of the project. (i.e., you may not call in for inspection simply to satisfy the requirements pertaining to frequency of inspections.)
