Town of Danville Update: 4.22.20

County Announces Drive-Thru COVID Testing Sites

On Wednesday afternoon, Contra Costa Health Services announced the opening of four new drive-thru COVID-19 testing sites in the county. Contra Costa County residents who have fever, cough, or symptoms of the novel coronavirus can call and make an appointment at one of the four sites, regardless of insurance.

Residents with these symptoms can call (844) 421-0804 for a confidential screening by a health professional. The screenings are conducted from 8:00 a.m. – 3:30 p.m. Monday-Friday. No walk-in appointments are allowed, all appointments must be made by call the phone number above.

Pittsburg Health Center, 2311 Loveridge Road, Pittsburg

West County Health Center, 23601 San Pablo Ave., San Pablo

Patients with appointments must travel in their personal vehicles to appointments. Testing is done without patients leaving vehicle, and results are available in 3-5 days.
